1. PRE-DEGREE SCIENCE PROGRAMME

Admissions will be into the following Schools:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates should possess WASC/NECO/GCE or NABTEB at not more than two sittings with a minimum of Credit passes in English Language, Mathematics, Physics and any two of the following subjects relevant to their discipline: Chemistry, Biology/Agric. Science, Economics, and Geography. Credit pass in Economics in compulsory in the School of Management Technology.

QUALIFYING TEST

Candidates for the Pre-Degree Science Programme must perform to a satisfactory level in a Computer-Based qualifying test to be conducted on Friday 5th and Saturday 6th November, 2010 at 9:00a.m. at the eTC CBT Centre, Federal University of Technology, Akure, Ondo State.

Candidates are expected to visit the Website of the Federal University of Technology, Akure www.futa.edu.ng for the results of the qualifying test from 15th November, 2010.

DURATION OF PROGRAMME: The programme is full-time and will run for one academic session of Two (2) Semesters.

REGISTRATION AND COMMENCEMENT OF LECTURES

Screening and registration of successful candidates begin on **Monday, 29th November, 2010** while lectures commence on **Monday, 6th December, 2010.**

Candidates who successfully complete the programme and meet the cut-off mark for the course applied for as determined by the University Admission Committee as well meet the JAMB cut-off mark would be admitted into 100 level of the University undergraduate degree programme in relevant discipline.

2. UNIVERSITY DIPLOMA IN SCIENCES PROGRAMME

Admissions will be into the following Schools:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates should possess O/L WASC/NECO/GCE or NABTEB at not more than two sittings with a minimum of Credit passes in English Language, Mathematics, Physics and any two of the following subjects relevant to their discipline: Chemistry, Biology/Agric. Science, Economics and Geography. Credit pass in Economics is compulsory in the School of Management Technology.

QUALIFYING TEST

Candidates for the University Diploma in Sciences Programme must perform to a satisfactory level in a Computer-Based qualifying test to be conducted on Saturday 11th December, 2010 at 9:00a.m. at the eTC CBT Centre of the Federal University of Technology, Akure, Ondo State.

Candidates are expected to visit the Website of the Federal University of Technology, Akure (www.futa.edu.ng) for the results of the qualifying test and the date of the screening of all successful candidates as from 20th December, 2010.

DURATION: The Programme is full time and will run for two academic sessions of four semesters.

Candidates who successfully complete the programme at a minimum grade level prescribed by the University Admission Committee would be admitted into the 200 level of the University undergraduate degree programme in relevant discipline through the JAMB Direct Entry mode.

REGISTRATION AND COMMENCEMENT OF LECTURES

Registration begins on Monday 20th December, 2010 while lectures commence on Monday, 3rd January, 2011.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

1. Candidates are to apply online by logging on to the Federal University of Technology's websites, www.futa.edu.ng, click on the Online PDS or UDS Application Form as from 26th July, 2010 as the case may be, complete and submit the Online Pre-Application form, and make a print out of the form showing the payment PIN CODE. *This PIN CODE must be used as the depositor's name (see illustration on the FUTA website).*
2. Following (1) above, candidates are to pay application fee of ten thousand naira (N10,000.00) for either PDS or UDS at the following underlisted designated bank accounts and await SMS confirmation of payment through the indicated GSM number on the Pre-Application Form. Thereafter revisit the website and complete the application form.

A. CERTIFICATE IN CRAFT TRAINING PROGRAMMES IN THE FOLLOWING:

- i. Fitting/Machining
- ii. Welding/Metal Fabrication
- iii. Furniture Craft
- iv. Electrical Installation

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

DURATION: Two (2) Years

B. PROFESSIONAL ENHANCEMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

As required by the professional bodies.

DURATION: Four Months and will run bi-annually:
January – April & July – October (Weekends)

C. EXECUTIVE CERTIFICATE IN GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. GCE O/Level or its equivalent with at least a Pass in English and Credit in three other subjects which preferably must include Mathematics, Geography/Technical Drawing.
- ii. At least three (3) years working experience.

DURATION: Three (3) Months (Full Time and Weekend runs are available)

D. COMPUTER AIDED DESIGN PROGRAMME FOR PROFESSIONALS

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. Five (5) Credits at WASC/NECO/GCE O'Level or NABTEB
- ii. Ten (10) years experience in professional practice.

DURATION: Four (4) Months (Weekends: Fridays & Saturdays)

E. EXECUTIVE CERTIFICATE COURSE IN TEXTILE DESIGN, GRAPHICS/PRINTING TECHNOLOGY, CERAMICS, AND POTTERY DESIGN

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

At least two (2) Credits passes at WASC/NECO/GCE O'Level or NABTEB

DURATION: One (1) Year of three (3) Terms

F. CERTIFICATE COURSE IN SPORTS SCIENCE

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Candidates must have minimum of three credit passes at WASC/NECO/GCE O'Level or NABTEB.
- b. Recommendation confirming cognate experience from Director of Sports, FUTA or from any other institution endorsed by the Director of Sports, FUTA

DURATION: Three (3) Semesters

G. CERTIFICATE COURSE IN METEOROLOGY

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. Candidates must have 5 credits in O'Level WASC/GCE in any of the following: Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Additional Mathematics or any other relevant subject;
- ii. World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Class II Meteorologist Certificate normally required for Direct Entry in the Department of Meteorology and/or a minimum of 7 years professional experience in any related field;
- iii. Graduates in related disciplines like Geography, Geology, Geophysics, Physics, Mathematics, Agric. etc

DURATION: The certificate course will be on full time and will last for five (5) months. This is made up of one (1) semester of course work and one (1) month of simple student research project.

H. COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAMME (MORNING & EVENING SESSIONS):

Training programmes are available in the following:

- a. Executive Certificate Course in Computer Studies (3 Months)
- b. Advanced Certificate Course in Computer Studies (3 Months)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- a. At least possession of Senior Secondary School Certificate or its equivalent for the Executive Certificate Course.
- b. To qualify for the Advanced Certificate Course, candidates must obtain a minimum of Upper Credit at the Executive Certificate Course.

I. CERTIFICATE COURSE IN POULTRY MANAGEMENT, ANIMAL PRODUCTION, FISHERY AND SNAIL FARMING (WEEKEND PROGRAMME)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Any literate Poultry/Fish farmer or those interested in Poultry/Fish farming can apply.

DURATION: Three (3) Months (Weekends: Fridays & Saturdays)

J. DIPLOMA IN FINANCE AND BUSINESS MANAGEMENT TECHNOLOGY

With the trend of development at the global level, there is the need to introduce technology into the curricula of Business and Financial Management in Nigeria in order to develop a middle-level manpower that will produce a high performance management framework.

In view of the above, the Diploma in Finance and Business Management Technology of the Centre has been packaged into various options to achieve the objective.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. Candidates should possess O/L WASC, NECO, GCE or NABTEB at not more than two sittings with a minimum of credit passes in English Language and Mathematics and any other two relevant subjects.

DURATION: Two Academic Sessions of 4 semesters.

K. DIPLOMA IN FORESTRY AND RANGE MANAGEMENT

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. Four Credits including English Language and Mathematics, at WASC/NECO/GCE O'Level or NABTEB
- ii. Mature candidates who have worked for at least five years in related area and who have undergone training at the Forestry Training School may be considered for admission.

DURATION: Two (2) Academic Sessions

L. DIPLOMA IN SPORTS SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Four Credits including English Language, Mathematics, Biology and any other subject at not more than two sittings at WASC/NECO/GCE O'Level or NABTEB.
- b. FUTA Certificate in Sports Science.

DURATION: Two (2) Academic Sessions

M. DIPLOMA IN LIBRARY MANAGEMENT

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- i. Four Credits including English Language and Mathematics, at WASC/NECO/GCE O'Level or NABTEB
- ii. Mature candidates who have worked for at least five years in related area and who have undergone Certificate Course in Library Management may be considered for admission.

DURATION: Two (2) Academic Sessions
